## Who is eligible to apply for The Promise?

The Promise serves high school graduates and works with need-based income thresholds for those who seek a degree in the fields of **Biology, Business, Communications, Criminal Justice, Elementary Education, Mathematics, Music, or Psychology**. All first-time-in-college students are eligible to apply.

## How do you qualify for The Promise?

- Complete the EWC admissions application for the fall 2018 term. **To apply, go to: [www.ewc.edu](http://www.ewc.edu)**. Contact: **Admissions Office: 904-470-8200; [admissions@ewc.edu](mailto:admissions@ewc.edu)**.
- Complete the **Free Application for Federal Student Aid Form (FAFSA)** and be eligible to receive the federal Pell grant. FAFSA website: [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov) and EWC's FAFSA code: **001478**.
- Receive an acceptance letter from the EWC Office of Admissions.
- **Must be a commuter student.**
