



Edward Waters College Division of Student Success and Engagement Students with Confirmed Positive COVID-19 Diagnosis

In preparation for when an on-campus resident gets diagnosed with COVID-19, the DSSE under the leadership of the Vice President or designee will implement the following protocols:

- Move student to a housing unit reserved for COVID-19 quarantine and isolation.
 - One unit of the Blue Honors Village housing has been identified to house quarantined or isolated students until medically cleared to return to their housing assignment.
- On-campus residents in isolation (official diagnosis of COVID-19) will require single room and will not share a bathroom.
- Quarantined residents (those exposed to COVID-19, notified through contact tracing, screening, or exhibiting symptoms), or may share a bathroom.
 - Currently, four (4) two bedroom/one bath apartments are available in the Blue Honors Village complex and can accommodate up to eight (8) quarantined or four (4) isolated students (or combination of both), with appropriate student life and academic support, as well as monitoring for further health consideration.
- Depending on housing type, (i.e. Ted Baker and Richardson Halls) students may be able to self-quarantine in their rooms.
- The DSSE will provide access to ongoing care and support during the period of quarantine/isolation.
- Counseling services will be accessible via teleconference health.
- The Dean of Students, or designated official, will follow-up with each student to provide support and to facilitate access to other services, as needed.
- The Division of Academic Affairs will support quarantined or isolated students to ensure minimal disruption to their academic progress. The Division of Finance, Administration, and Business Innovation and Division of Student Success and Engagement will provide food service delivery to serve impacted students.
