

Important measures used to track institutional progress toward our goals include student enrollment, course completion rates, retention rates, graduation rates, degrees awarded, graduate school attendance, and job placement rates.

EWC's goal is to attain at least a 55% Fall-to-Fall retention rate for students who enrolled as First-Time-In-College (FTIC) freshmen during the Fall 2020.

EWC's goal is to attain at least 30% six-year graduation rate by Fall 2021 for students who enrolled as FTIC freshmen during the Fall 2015.
